**March 18:** Presentation from Jackie Jenks of the IFC.

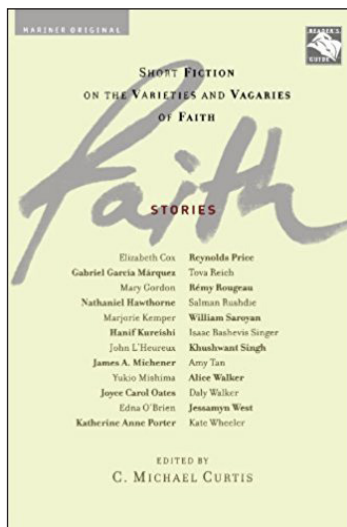
**March 25:** Presentation from Brian Kileff about the Kachele Village Project in Zambia.
