In Haiti, HRP is part of the CODEP project - the Comprehensive Development Program. It is in a community of over 700 farm families in the mountains of Haiti. Begun in 1989 with support from churches in North Carolina and Virginia, CODEP has become **a powerhouse example of reforestation success**, having planted over 15 million trees. This work has **revitalized the rural community** and the greater area now boasts a church, a school, a micro-financing institution, various entrepreneurial enterprises, and a store. Gardens now grow in the community, groundwater is much safer, and the trees help avert catastrophic flooding and mudslides.
