The Latin Patriarchate School in Zababdeh on the West Bank of Palestine has partnered with University Presbyterian Church for more than twenty years, with the first students that UPC helped support **enrolled in colleges and higher education institutions there**. The economic isolation of the West Bank under the Occupation has left many parents without jobs and thus without resources to provide their children with hope for a brighter future. The school serves over 600 Christian and Muslim boys and girls from preschool through 12th grade. By teaching peaceful solutions and providing an education, the Latin Patriarchate School promises children **a brighter future in the midst of war**. Father Firas, the parish leader there, reminds us at UPC that he is always working to "build peace on the desks of the children."
